### Business Bowl Competition

### (Double Elimination)

#### Team and Entry requirements

1. Teams will consist of a Coach, (4) Team members; (With one as designated Captain) and (1) alternate. (5 total members)
2. Team Roster DEADLINE is March 2, 2012. The roster can only be changed in *emergencies* documented in writing with all requirements met for verification. (GPA, number of hours enrolled, etc.)
3. The alternate can only replace a team member for an entire match, not one of the (2) sessions.
4. Only the team captain can raise an objection during the match. (The dispute must be settled before the match resumes)
5. We recommend that the team captain accompany their coach to the coaches meeting when the teams will be drawn and placed on the bracket.

#### Match/Sessions

1. There will be (2) fifteen-minute sessions to determine the winner of each *match* with a 5 minute break between sessions.
2. Points will be awarded for each correct answer; no points will be deducted for incorrect answers.
3. Times will be posted for each match and there will be a 5 minute grace period for the teams to arrive and check in with the judges. Teams failing to meet the grace period will forfeit the match.
4. **Quizmaster** will be in charge of the match. After team introductions the Quizmaster will conduct the coin toss, the winner of the coin toss will gain control of the board and will select the category for the first question to be read by the Quizmaster. (The second session begins with control of the Board by the Team *not* winning the initial coin toss.)
5. Winner of each match will be determined by the accumulated points from the (2) sessions.
6. In the event of a tie, the Quizmaster will announce and proceed to a “sudden death” round. The Quizmaster will select the question(s) and the team with the first correct answer wins the match.

#### Questions/Answering:

1. Upon the reading of the question, the team that buzzes in first has (15) seconds to answer the question. (There will be *no* re-read of the question for the 1<sup>st</sup> buzz-in.) If not answered correctly, the second team must buzz in and has 15 seconds to answer the question. The second team to buzz- in can ask for (1) re-read of the question. If no team answers the question correctly the control of the board remains the same; if a question is answered correctly by a team then that team gains/retains control of the board.
2. Teams can buzz in *before* the question is fully read; the reading of the question is *stopped immediately* and the 15 second timer is started and no re-read of the question is done for the team buzzing in first. Again, if the answer is *incorrect* from the first buzz- in the *other* team can buzz in and answer the question or request a re-read of the question and has 15 seconds to answer.

3. Teams responding to questions must answer clearly and completely; *partial* answers will not be considered correct answers.
4. Any team member can buzz-in; Discussion among the team members is allowable, but the individual team member who buzzed-in must answer within the 15 seconds.

**Reference material:**

All questions will be derived from various textbooks within the field of business. The five categories to be utilized in this bowl will be: Accounting, Management, Economics, Personal Finance and Marketing. No question will be utilized more than one time.

**Conduct during the competition:**

1. Once the time to start is announced, the doors to the competition rooms will be closed.
2. The first row seats in both competition rooms are reserved for the teams themselves.
3. All audience members are expected to maintain the highest degree of conduct within the room; this means no interruptions, loud conversation, any hand or lip motions directed towards the team(s) will be tolerated. Any individuals violating these rules will be asked to leave the room.
4. In the case of assistance from audience members directed towards their team during the match; that team will forfeit the match.
5. Short-sequence videotaping of the competitions will be allowed: (3-5 minutes). However, no electrical cords or accommodations to the camera person will allowed; (we advise you to take pictures before the competition starts or during the break). Remember, the Quizmaster, judges and time/scorekeepers are on a tight schedule and they reserve the right to end any and all videotaping at any time.
6. The Quizmaster administers the match; any disputes during the match can be settled by the judge(s). The judge(s) will have 2 minutes to make a decision. Time will be stopped during this interval and restarted following the decision of the judge(s). The ruling of judge(s) is final.
7. Teams are limited to 3 challenges per session.
