RULES, etc:

1. Each TCU selects or writes their own One Act Play. If script is not TCU original, all copyright issues are the responsibility of that TCU.
2. Costumes are allowed and are considered to be the character attire worn by players. Masks are considered part of the costume and are allowed.
3. Props are allowed. However, they must be actively utilized by characters during performance.
4. The maximum time limit for each TCU One Act Play is **20 minutes**.
5. The minimum time limit for each TCU One Act Play is **13 minutes**.
6. Items for set design (other than props – see criteria in #3) such as lighting, projector, backdrop, microphones/PA, scenery, CD player, etc. are **prohibited**. **AUDIO:** TCU students must naturally project their voice during performance as no microphones or PA system are provided. A CD player will be provided for performance usage.
7. Actors must meet overall student enrollment criteria.
