The following inquiry is being sent to you to determine if you may be interested in having your child in Grades K-2 attend our Lakota Immersion School during the school year 2010-2011.

The focus of our school is to preserve the Lakota Language and daily learning activities will be conducted in Lakota with appropriate translation for those of us who are learning the language.

Lakota Woglake Wounspe (OLC's Immersion School) will be moving to the Piya Wiconi campus next year. We will be expanding our service to include students in grades K-2. We are planning to begin the school day at 7:45 AM and end it at 5:00 PM. Tentatively the plan is that no transportation (bus service) will be provided. Parents (care givers) will be expected to deliver and pick up students within or at the beginning and ending times.

Due to the extended hours we are anticipating having to limit the enrollment. We will be limiting this to a maximum of thirty (30) students or approximately eight (8) per grade. Students will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis at the time and date that we will begin actual enrollment.

Further announcement will be made as to when enrollment begins and as to the process.
