

## Psy 103 General Psychology – Spring 2017 – Video Report

Your last short assignment consists of writing a brief video report. Go to <http://clipsforclass.com>: This site includes links to many psychology-related videos organized by topic (the different tabs at the top). Pick any video from this page, watch it, and then write your video report about it. The following needs to be included:

- Your name
- Topic area (e.g. “motivation,” “personality,” etc.)
- Title of video
- Description: a brief summary of the video (approximately a 4-5-sentence paragraph)
- Questions: respond to all the questions that are listed on <http://clipsforclass.com> next to the video
- Reflection: What is your reaction to the video? Use critical thinking – not just “I liked it” or “I didn’t like it.” Was the material helpful to you? Why or why not? What is the piece’s point of view? What could the author have done better?
- Analysis: Use concepts, terms, and ideas from class to assess the video. How does it tie into the readings, lecture, or class discussion? **Talk about psychology and concepts from the course!**
- At least 250 words; typed
