

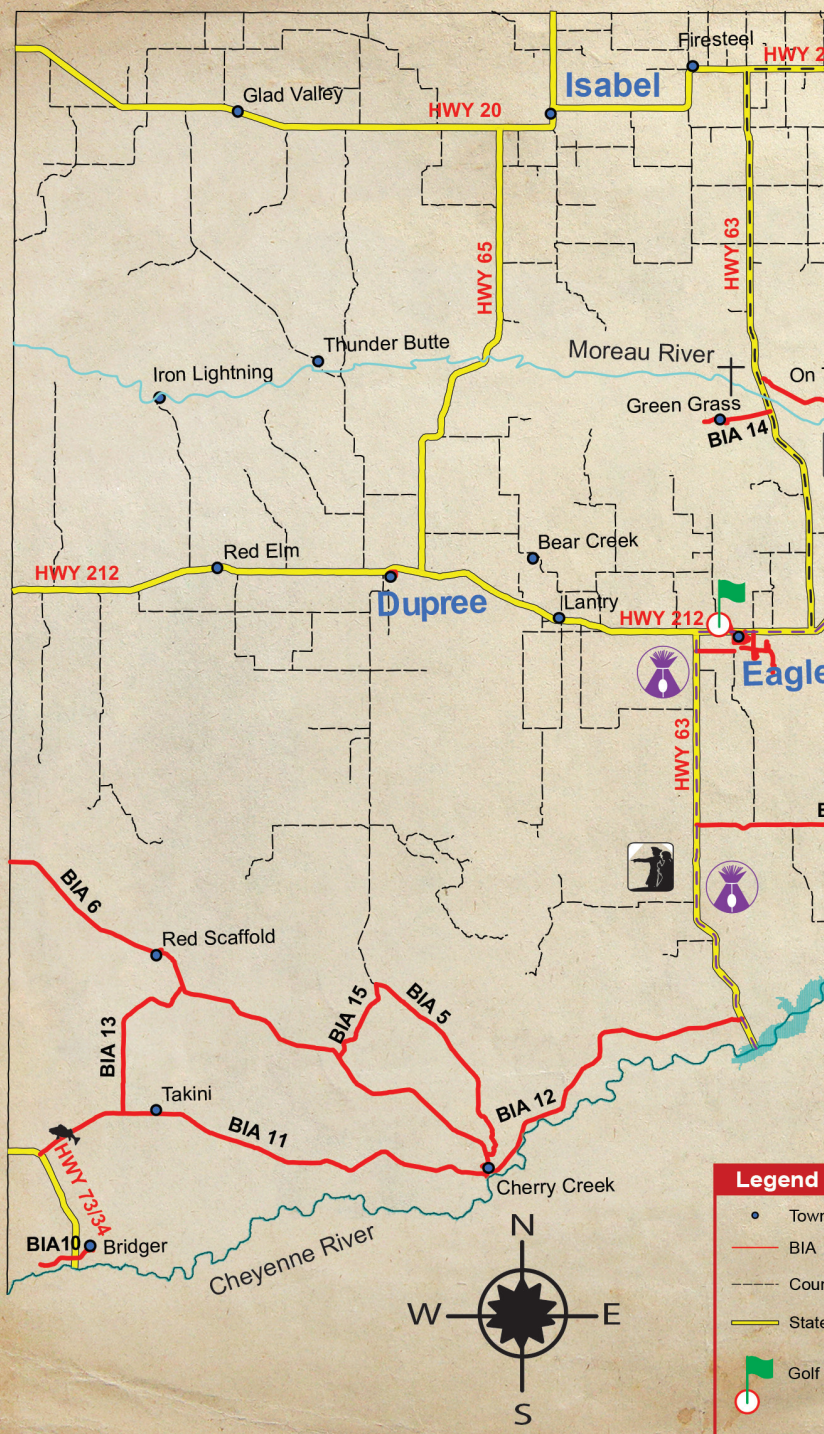

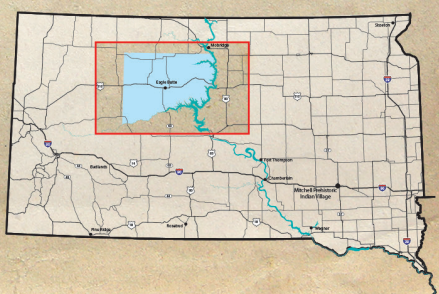


The community resources in this guide are from 2018 and will change as the community develops and grows. This guide features community resources available to the Cheyenne River area. It does not include all businesses.
